#### GENDER CLAUSULE

### **SCHEDULE CALL ROOM REQUIREMENTS**

Athletes will be able to access the track after passing through the call room, located in the basement. From here, athletes will enter the track accompanied by a judge. The track must be vacated through the same area.

Call room judges will monitor, in accordance with WA and RFEA Regulations. Remember that the call room judge may request identification from athletes through the presentation of the athlete card, ID, or other official documentation proving their identity.

### **TECHNICAL RULES**

#### **BIBS**

Participating athletes must collect their bibs up to 1 hour before the start of the events. Bibs cannot be manipulated, and the Referee Judge may prevent the participation of those who do not comply with this rule.

When only one bib is issued, in races, it must be visibly placed on the front of the shirt.

#### **WARM-UP AREA**

It is located in the basement of the track. There is a straight track and a long jump pit. Access will be through the side staircase.

#### **RESULTS**

Results can be consulted online and in real-time on the FCA website.

#### **MEDICAL SERVICES**

Medical service facilities are located in the basement of the track. Likewise, medical personnel will be located in the back straight area of the track.

#### **COMPETITION**

In 60 m and 60 **mh**: The top 8 marks from the different semifinals qualify for the final.

In 400 m, 800 m, and 1.500 m: Overall classification will be based on times from the different finals, regardless of whether it is "A," "B," "C," or "D" final.

In Shot Put and Long Jump: Attempts will be made successively in the female and male categories. The top 10 athletes will advance, 5 from the female category and 5 from the male category. Improvement attempts will be made in reverse order of the classification of the first 3 attempts (first the Female category and then the Male category).

#### **BAR PLACEMENT**

Women Pole Vault: 3,61 – 3,81 – 4,01 +0,05 m

Men Pole Vault: 4,90 – 5,10 – 5,25 – 5,40 – 5,50 +0,05 m

Take-off marks will be provided by the judges of the respective events. Athletes cannot leave the competition area without being accompanied by a member of the jury. The length of the spikes must not exceed 6 mm.

### IMPLEMENTS APPROVAL

The organization will provide a sufficient number of approved implements to carry out throwing events.

Athletes wishing to use personal implement must deliver them 1 hour before the start of the event to the Technical Director of the competition, so they can be verified and then they will be responsible for transferring them to the competition area.

### PRIZES

There will be prizes for the top 3 marks in each event (in 60m and 60 t, only the FINAL will be considered): 750 – 500 – 300 €.

To be eligible for the cash prize, the following marks must be exceeded:
