



# RULES OF THE BARCELONA CITY MEETING May 19th, 2024 - Continental Tour Bronze Estadi Joan Serrahima - Barcelona

## GENDER CLAUSE

The Catalan Athletics Federation guarantees effective equality between women and men as one of the basic principles of action. For this purpose, generic references in the masculine gender in the articles of their published regulations will also be understood to refer to their corresponding feminine, except in cases where it is specifically stated otherwise.

#### SCHEDULE OF CALL ROOM

Athletes will be able to access the track after passing through the requirements chamber, which is located at the exit curve of the 400/800m. From here, athletes will access the track accompanied by a judge. The track must be vacated through the same area. The judges of the requirements chamber will monitor, in accordance with WA and RFEA regulations. It should be noted that the judge of the requirements chamber may request identification from athletes by presenting their athlete card, ID card, or other official documentation proving their identity.

## **TECHNICAL RULES**

#### **BIB NUMBERS**

Participating athletes must collect their bib numbers up to 1 hour before the start of the events. Bib numbers cannot be manipulated, and the Chief Referee may prevent the participation of anyone who does not comply with this rule. When only one bib number is issued, in races, it must be visibly placed on the front of the shirt.

## WARM-UP ZONE

It is located on the opposite side of the stadium.

## RESULTS

Results can be consulted online and in real-time on the FCA website.

## MEDICAL SERVICES

Medical service facilities are located in the arrival area. Likewise, medical personnel will be situated in the arrival area.

## COMPETITION

100m: The top 8 best times from the different semifinals qualify for the final.

Mixed triple jump: Attempts will be made successively in the female and male categories. Girls will perform each attempt first, followed by the male category. All athletes will proceed to the improvement round. Improvement attempts will be made in reverse order of the classification of the first 3 attempts (first the Female category and then the Male).

## **Bar Placement**

Women's pole vault: 3.55-3.70-3.85-4.00-4.10-4.20-4.30-4.40-4.45 +5cm Women's high jump: 1.73-1.77-1.81-1.84-1.87-1.90-1.92 +2cm

Signals for take-off will be provided by the judges of the respective events. Athletes may not leave the competition area without being accompanied by a member of the jury. In competitions, spikes may not exceed 9 mm and 12mm for high jump.

#### **Equipment Homologation**

The organization will provide a sufficient number of homologated materials to carry out the throwing events. Athletes wishing to use personal equipment must submit them to the Technical Director of the competition 1 hour before the start of the event for verification, and then they will be responsible for transporting them to the competition area.





#### Prizes

There will be prizes for the top 5 performances in each event (only the FINAL will be considered for the 100m).

100m, 800m, 400m, High jump, Pole vault, and Hammer throw for women: 900-600-400-200-100 euros

200m, 400m, 800m, 5,000m, and Men's Shot put: 900-600-400-200-100 euros Mixed Triple Jump: 900-500-300-125 euros for each gender.

To be eligible for the cash prize, the following standards must be exceeded:
